
A Victory for the Palestinian People as the Struggle Continues!

USPCN Statement on the "Temporary Truce Agreement"

This Special Supplement Edition of the Peoples' Senate Newsletter features two guest articles from the Palestinian Community both here in the US and in Palestine

The U.S. Palestinian Community Network (USPCN) salutes our steadfast Palestinian and Arab people for their courageous self-defense and unified resistance to the ongoing U.S.-backed Israeli genocide against our people in all of Palestine, especially Gaza.

Although we mourn, with deep sadness and grief, the 14,000 Palestinians who have already been killed, which includes 5,500 children, USPCN recognizes the recent truce agreement between the unified Palestinian resistance and Israel as an interim victory for the Palestinian people, a clear indication that Israel failed to meet its military objectives after October 7th. With this deal, 150 Palestinian women and child political prisoners will be liberated from occupation jails, humanitarian aid will enter Gaza, and the besieged people of Gaza will gain at least five days of reprieve from vicious, U.S.-backed Israeli bombing. The Resistance also knows that it now has political leverage to force an extension of this suspension of Israel's war crimes against the people.

The demand of the Resistance, from day one, was an exchange of Israelis (including a number of very high-ranking military officials) captured on October 7th and Palestinian political prisoners in Israeli jails. Israel rejected the deal, and instead, vowed to "eliminate the resistance" and "turn Gaza into a parking lot." Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu repeatedly stated that there would be no end to the attacks... but the Resistance has forced Israel to concede. [...]

Even with its ground invasion

and all the damage it inflicted upon the people of Gaza, Israel's occupation forces and government still failed to achieve any significant military or political victories, and even the blatant propaganda videos and pictures of the Israeli (Continued on page 2)

army in Gaza's hospitals and schools tell the truth of failure and defeat. The unified Palestinian resistance, which, under international law, has the right to resist illegal occupation by any means necessary, continue fighting back and resisting the aggression [...]

The series of events that started on October 7th have changed the power dynamic in the region forever, and shortened the life of the racist, white supremacist, apartheid, Zionist Israeli occupation. The Palestinian people have shattered the idea of an "invincible" Israeli army, and proven that even an army in possession of the most advanced warfare technology is capable of being confronted and challenged...
[...] Israel is being exposed as what it is: a criminal, illegal, racist, settler-colonialist state.
The genocide also exposes Joe

Biden and all those in the U.S. political establishment who are cheerleaders for war crimes and genocide. It exposes their double standards, anti-Arab racism, and hypocrisy, and makes it clear that they care only for the U.S. empire and not at all for the lives of oppressed people like Palestinians.

But we must remain steadfast and understand that Israel is not to be trusted...We must continue to be out in the streets, pay close attention to the political guidance of our people back home, and never waver in our demands to stop the

genocide immediately, end the siege on Gaza now, and end all U.S. aid to Israel. [...]

The will to resist and to return and live on our historical land has never wavered. On the contrary; it has grown stronger, even after the past 45 days, and we can see our liberation more clearly than ever. The brave Palestinian people and their unified resistance will continue to stand tall against the U.S.-backed Zionist aggression! We mourn with them our martyrs, and we pledge to continue organizing until Liberation and Return!

Long live the Palestinian struggle for National Liberation and equality! Long live International Solidarity! Long Live Palestine!



Ending complicity in international crimes: a two-way arms embargo on Israel



The statement below has been initiated by Al-Haq, Women's International League for Peace and Freedom, and International Service for Human Rights. They invite signers ongoing. We have excerpted the statement for purposes of inclusion in this special edition of the Peoples' Senate Newsletter. The undersigned organizations demand that States that have provided and continue to provide arms and other forms of military assistance to Israel, adhere to their legal obligations and act resolutely and urgently to prevent Israel from perpetuating further international crimes and other serious violations of international law. This includes their obligations to prevent the

commission of genocide.

We remind these States that their binding obligations under international humanitarian law, international human rights law, international criminal law, and other international law, including the United Nations (UN) Charter, require that they put an immediate stop to such transfers, and suspend all licenses for arms destined to Israel from their jurisdictions.

States parties to the Arms
Trade Treaty (ATT) have additional binding obligations under the treaty, and so do States under relevant regional and national legal instruments on arms control.
We recall that providing arms or military support to Israel may make exporting States complicit in its actions.

[...] On 27 October, the UN General Assembly, in a resolution adopted at its emergency special session, stressed "the imperative, under international humanitarian law, of ensuring that civilians are not deprived of objects indispensable to their survival."

Statements by Israeli officials urged that "the emphasis is on damage and not on accuracy", and called for "erasing the Gaza Strip from the face of the earth".

[...]Between 7 October and 2:00 pm on November 5, 2023, in the West Bank, including Jerusalem,

the Israeli occupying forces and settlers killed 149 Palestinians, including 44 children. Furthermore, the Knesset's National Security Committee continued with "the government's broader plan to arm Jewish Israeli civilians", by loosening Israel's gun control and reportedly making an additional 400,000 Jewish-Israelis eligible to have a license for guns.

In the midst of these attacks, and despite well-documented and reported grave violations and crimes against the Palestinian population over the years, the supply of arms and military support to Israel from the United States (US), — the largest single provider of military aid to Israel for decades,— and from Canada, Germany, Italy, the United Kingdom (UK), and the Netherlands — States Parties to the ATT, has continued. [...]

At its 2021 Special Session on the grave human rights situation in the Occupied Palestinian Territory, including East Jerusalem, the UN Human Rights Council urged all States to refrain from transferring arms when they assess that there is a clear risk that such arms might be used to commit or facilitate serious violations or abuses of international human rights law or serious violations of international humanitarian law.
